ARTICLE 9. BOARD OF ELDERS AND DEACONS

- The Board of Elders and Deacons shall include all Elders, Deacons, and the Clergy being ex-officio members.
- The Board of Elders and Deacons shall have the Chairman, the Vice Chairman and the Secretary, who shall be selected from the members of the Board.
- The Board of Elders and Deacons shall be responsible for general church administration, budgeting and internal affairs, and assisting the Clergy to minister to the LVCCC.
- The Board of Elders and Deacons shall establish the rules and regulations for general church administration and internal affairs in accordance with the LVCCC Bylaws.
- The Board of Elders and Deacons shall evaluate regularly all ministries and programs to make sure that they meet the spiritual needs of the LVCCC.
- 6. The Board Elders and Deacons shall meet every month. Additional board meetings can be called by the Chairman. If necessary, the Chairman may call for a joint session of the Board of Elders and Deacons and the Board of Directors.
- 7. The Board of Elders and Deacons shall appoint ad hoc committees according to the needs of the LVCCC.
- 8. The Board of Elders and Deacons shall be responsible for making recommendations for the following major business items to the General Assembly for approval:
 - a. nomination of the Director, Deacon, or Elder;
 - b. hiring of the Professional Staff;
 - c. dismissal of the Professional Staff;
 - d. removal of the Director, Deacon, or Elder;
 - e. bylaw amendments.
- 9. No two members from one family shall be elected to the Board of Elders and Deacons and/or the Board of Directors.
