## **ARTICLE 11. DEACONS**

## **Section 1. Qualifications**

- 1. A candidate must
  - a. be a member of the LVCCC;
  - b. have been baptized for at least three years;
  - c. have served the LVCCC ministry at least one year.
- 2. The faith and life of a candidate must fit the Biblical teaching as stated in 1 Timothy 3: 8-13.
- 3. A candidate must be willing to serve on the Board of Elders and Deacons.

## **Section 2. Election**

- The number of newly elected Deacons shall not exceed the number of Deacons remaining on the Board of Elders and Deacons.
- The Board of Elders and Deacons shall solicit nominations for Deacons at least three months before a regular session of the General Assembly.
- 3. Candidates for Deacons shall be approved by the Board of Elders and Deacons, and shall be announced to the General Assembly at least four weeks before the election.
- New Deacons shall be elected by simple majority of the General Assembly from the candidates approved by the Board of Elders and Deacons.
- 5. The term of a Deacon shall be two years.
- A Deacon shall be eligible for re-election.

## Section 3. Responsibilities

- 1. The responsibilities of Deacons shall include but are not limited to:
  - a. assisting the Clergymen and Elders in promoting the spiritual growth of the LVCCC;
