- Current memberships are reviewed by the Board of Elders and Deacons, and renewed automatically prior to the annual meeting of the General Assembly.
- 4. The list of memberships shall be updated periodically by the Board of Elders and Deacons.

## **Section 3. Termination**

- 1. Membership may be terminated by voluntary withdrawal or transfer to other churches upon notification to the Board of Elders and Deacons.
- 2. Membership may be terminated automatically after six months of absence in the LVCCC worship services without notifying the Board of Elders and Deacons the reason for his/her absence.
- 3. Membership will be automatically terminated upon a member's death.
- 4. Membership may be terminated due to a member's actions that are contrary to Biblical teachings or the interests or general welfare of the LVCCC as determined by the Board of Elders and Deacons. If it becomes necessary for the LVCCC to take actions to terminate such a member, a written notice of expulsion from the Board of Elders and Deacons shall be given to such a member.

## **Section 4. Rights and Obligations**

## Rights:

- 1. A member shall have the right to vote at meetings of the General Assembly.
- 2. A member shall have the right to present motions of congregational interest to the Board of Elders and Deacons and to inquire about the activities of the LVCCC.
- 3. Only a member can be nominated and/or hold the positions of Deacon or Elder.
- 4. Only a member can be nominated to the Board of Directors, or invited to be a ministry team leader.

## **Obligations:**

1. Members are expected to support the decisions made by the Board of Elders and Deacons and/or the General Assembly.
