- investigation. Results of the investigation shall be conveyed to both parties in writing.
- c. Should the matter turned out to be unfounded, it shall be handled in accordance with Article 3.3.4 of the LVCCC Bylaw. Should the matter be found true and constitute grounds for dismissal of the Clergyman in question, the Board of Elders and Deacons and the Board of Directors shall jointly review the investigation report. Upon agreement by a three-quarters majority of the joint session of the Board of Elders and Deacons and the Board of Directors, the Clergyman shall be dismissed.

Section 2. Other Professional Staff

Other professional staff members such as the financial secretary, the general management secretary, etc., may be hired at the discretion of the Board of Elders and Deacons.

ARTICLE 7. GENERAL ASSEMBLY

- The General Assembly shall hold regular sessions at least once a year.
- Special sessions of the General Assembly can be called through the request of the Board of Elders and Deacons, the Board of Directors, or upon written petition by one quarter of members of the LVCCC.
- Members shall be notified in writing or weekly bulletin at least fourteen days in advance of all regular or special sessions of the General Assembly.
- 4. To constitute a quorum at the General Assembly, at least one-half of members must be present. When a quorum is not satisfied, the session shall be dissolved and be called again according to the guidelines outlined in Article 7.3.
- 5. Absentee ballots shall be null and void at the General Assembly.

ARTICLE 8. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

1. The Board of Directors shall consist of the President, the Treasurer, the Secretary, and Directors. The Directors are hereby designated
